- **For overnight use**
 - **Check in is 3:00 PM** (MST) the first day of your reservation.
 - **Check-out is 12:00 PM**(MST) the last day of your reservation
- **For day use**
 - **Please check in and out at your designated time.**
- There is a keypad for Pawnee Lodge that is located on the front door.
- Pawnee Lodge is available for free day use for troops and other Girl Scout groups. All groups using the facility must book their time through our online reservation system. If you arrive and a group is using the facility who has not made a booking, they should be asked to leave. If any concerns or issues arise please contact the Property and Outdoor Program Administrator at property.reservations@gscolorado.org.
- If you will be staying overnight, please call the local police department upon your arrival to alert them that you will be staying overnight, so they know the facility is being used. The phone number is located on the small bulletin board in the lodge.

Vehicles

- There is parking for four cars comfortably, and there may be additional parking available at the park.
- All vehicles are the sole responsibility of the owner.
- Girl Scouts of Colorado will not be responsible for any fees incurred.
- We strongly suggest that during snow season (September through April) that you only bring vehicles that are all-wheel-drive or front-wheel-drive. If this is not possible you should at least have chains on hand for rear wheel drive vehicles.
- No RVs are permitted on Girl Scout properties.

The Lodge

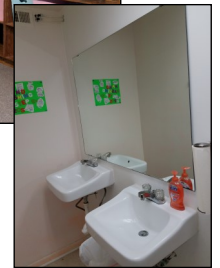
Pawnee Lodge is comprised of a main area on the bottom floor, and a loft upstairs, where guests can store their belongings during the day in order to use the main area for activities.

Pawnee Lodge has a kitchen with a refrigerator, stove, microwave, coffee pot, and oven. There are some basic supplies in the kitchen for cooking, such as cookware, baking dishes and cooking utensils, however no plates, bowls, or silverware are provided. Guests should also bring disposable products such as aluminum foil, paper towels, and seasonings.

Your group can use table-top propane grills for outdoor cooking options. Please check on local fire bans before planning for this option. There is no outdoor fire ring.

Pawnee has one bathroom. Toilet paper, paper towels, and cleaning supplies are provided, however we ask that guests replace any supplies that they use before they leave. Pawnee Lodge does not have a shower.

Guests will sleep on mattresses on the floor. Pawnee can sleep up to ten people overnight.



Clean Up

Girl Scouts should be sure to leave places as clean or cleaner than they found them. Guests who do not complete the required cleaning may be charged a cleaning fee.

Pawnee Lodge does not have a Site Manager, and the property is cleaned by each troop that uses the facility.

Cleaning expectations

- Clean up from all activities and remove programming materials
- Sweep floor, and mop if there were any spills
- Clean bathroom
- Remove all trash, and place into Dumpster
- Clean all kitchen surfaces you have used
- Take all food with you: do not leave it in the refrigerator
- Turn off all lights, and lock the door

Driving Directions

From Highway 76

1. Exit at Sterling exit.
2. Go through the town of Sterling (Hwy 14).
3. The Lodge is located in Pioneer Park on the west end of town.
4. There is a lockbox on the front door of Pawnee Lodge
