Did you know?

Nuestra Cabaña, (also known as "Our Cabaña"), is one of the 5 WAGGGS (World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts) World Centers. It is located in the "City of Eternal Spring", Cuernavaca, Mexico. This second WAGGGS World Center opened on July 24, 1957.



History of Nuestra Cabaña

During the peak of the Covid-19 pandemic, Nuestra Cabaña faced possible closure due to financial challenges. In response, Girl Scouts and Guides worldwide rallied to raise awareness and funds, leading to the transfer of ownership from Guias de Mexico to WAGGGS. While operations are still recovering, Nuestra Cabaña is once again welcoming volunteers, guests, and hosting programs.

Since opening, it has hosted over 70,000 Girl Guides and Scouts from around the globe. As the largest WAGGGS World Centre, it accommodates up to 108 guests and features dormitories, a year-round pool, a campfire circle, vibrant local flora, and views of Popocatepetl and Iztaccihuatl volcanoes. Don't miss the iconic blue front door—The Chief's Door—donated by Lady Baden-Powell.



Things to do at Nuestra Cabana

Whether you're visiting solo or with a group, Nuestra Cabaña offers enriching experiences for everyone. Programs range from single-day visits to multi-week stays.

Day visitors can enjoy guided tours of the property, take part in pinning ceremonies, and engage in meaningful community service projects.

Groups of 10 or more can plan a customized day program—perfect when no other events are scheduled. Just be sure to arrange it in advance!

Nuestra Cabaña also hosts a variety of **WAGGS programs**, both on-site and online, celebrating Mexican culture, nature, and global friendship. Some of the most popular and transformative experiences include:

Nuestra Cabana Volunteering:

Nuestra Cabaña hosts on-site and remote volunteers who are passionate and can commit to a 6 months to 1 year term. You would be part of a team of 4-8 volunteers (depending on the season). Gain a global connection with Girl Guides and Girl Scouts from around the world, immerse yourself in Mexican traditions, cuisine, and festivals, gain leadership, teamwork, and communication skills, all in the unique setting of this WAGGGS World Center in Cuernavaca, Mexico.
