

Leader-in-Action (LiA) Award

Requirements

Girl Scout Cadettes, show off your leadership skills and earn your Leader-in-Action (LiA) Award by assisting your Brownie sisters at their meetings.

To earn your LiA award:

1. Find a group of Girl Scout Brownies who are starting a Journey or badge you are interested in.
 - a. If you don't know any Brownie troops, ask a troop leader or service volunteer for assistance.
2. Connect with the Brownies' troop leaders to discover how you can assist during their meetings.
 - a. Learn about the Brownies' interests and find out what types of challenges they are facing.
 - b. Make sure you read the requirements for what badge or Journey they are completing!
3. Collaborate with the troop leaders to schedule **FOUR** dates and times that work for everyone.
4. Plan your activities! Make sure each is fun, engaging, and appropriate for the girls' program level.
 - If you're unsure about any part of your plan, don't hesitate to ask questions!
5. After completing your activities, ask their troop leader for feedback on your performance - what worked well, what might you do differently next time.



Now that you've finished the project part of your LiA, answer these questions:

- What did you **Discover** about yourself as you guided Brownies?
- In what ways did you **Connect** with Brownies? Why is it important to engage with younger girls?
- How did you encourage Brownies to **Take Action**?
