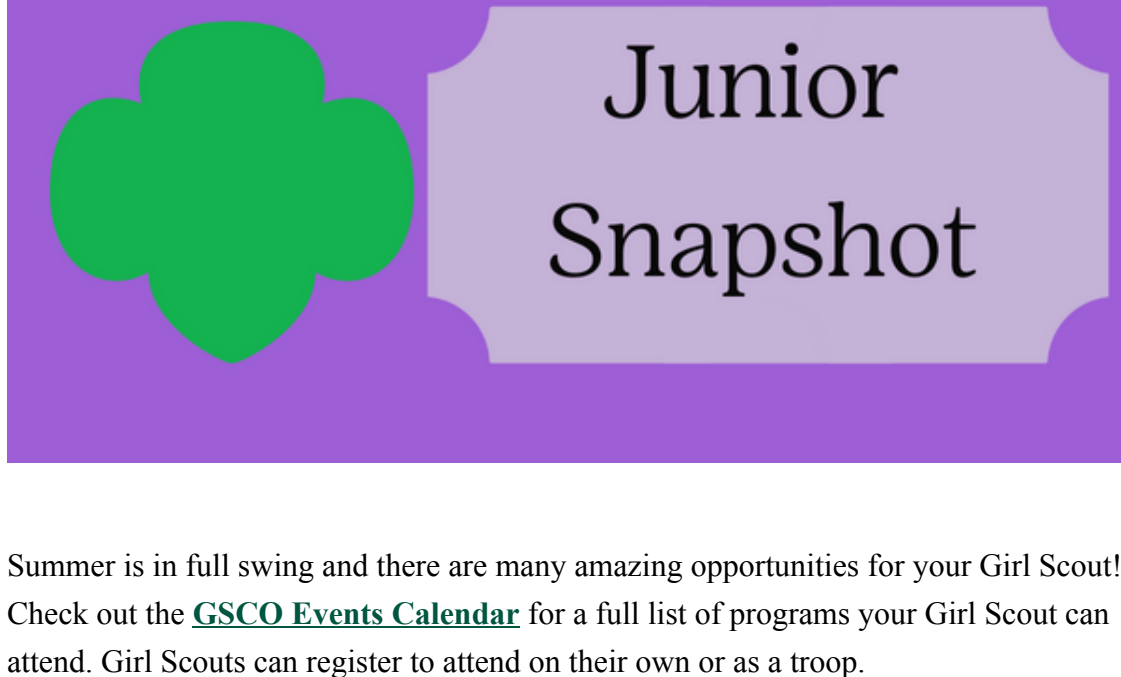




Junior Snapshot is a newsletter for GSCO families.

- Grow personal, social, and professional skills while having fun

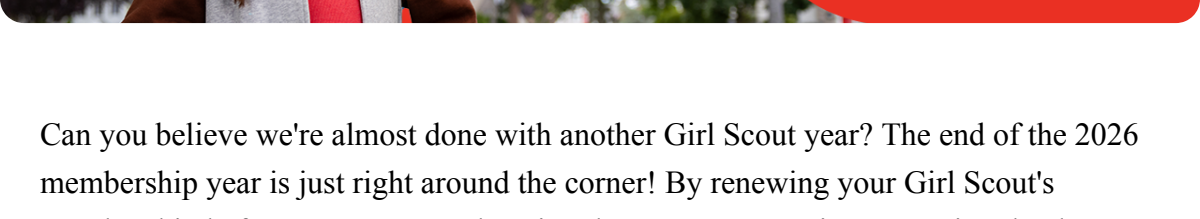
Who Should Apply
