Look Wider International Travel Scholarship

In December 2013, the **Rae Ann and Richard E. Dougherty Look Wider International Travel Fund was established to provide Colorado Girl Scouts (up to age 30) with funding to fulfill their travel dreams** while discovering the magic and power of the international sisterhood of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts. Scholarships are awarded through a selection process of candidate(s) who satisfy the requirements and complete the application. Typical awards are between \$100 and \$500.
